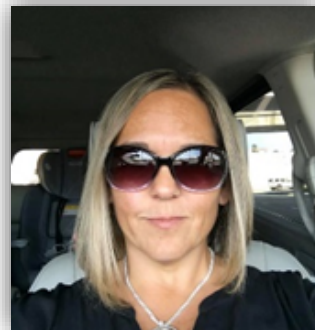

History of the Southern California Mothers of Multiples Twin Club

First Annual Workshop – November 14, 1968

The first annual workshop was held at El Modena High School in Orange County, California. The meeting was called to order by President Betty Hoffman on November 14, 1968. Central Orange County M.O.T.C. served as the hosting club. Nineteen clubs were represented, with 113 members attending.

A suggested bylaw change was read and discussed. After a lengthy discussion, it was voted to accept the bylaw changes. Registration fees were established at 50 cents for evening workshop meetings and one dollar for conventions. The organization also purchased Robert's Rules of Order for use by the parliamentarian.

The nominating committee was appointed with two representatives from each area. Kathy Osman, representing the West Side M.O.T.C., reported on national research, particularly the work being done at Joslin Laboratories and the diabetic questionnaire, stressing the importance of each member completing a form. The speaker for the evening was Ellen Woods of S&H Green Stamps, who spoke on membership, ways and means, and parliamentary procedures.

Second Annual Convention – May 24, 1969

The second annual convention was held May 24, 1969, in Escondido, California. Escondido M.O.T.C. served as the host club.

Nineteen clubs were represented with 111 persons registered. President Betty Hoffman called the meeting to order at the Fireside Restaurant in Escondido. Ralph Elliott of the Escondido Chamber of Commerce presented National Representative Capi Osman with a basket of fruit as a welcome to S.C.M.O.T.C. for holding their convention in the city. Members were also welcomed by Mayor Crow. The slate of officers was presented and elections were held.

The following officers were elected:

President: Betty Hoffman – Santa Anita M.O.T.C.

Vice President: Winnie Sells – Simi Valley M.O.T.C.

Recording Secretary: D. Brewer – Santa Barbara M.O.T.C.

Corresponding Secretary: Ruby Bancher – Whittier M.O.T.C.

Treasurer: Alice Clifton – Huntington Beach M.O.T.C.

The installation ceremony was conducted by Dot Barnett. Vice President Winnie Sells presented Betty Hoffman with a gift from the new board members: a gold charm bracelet with a gold gavel.

Second Annual Workshop – November 13, 1969

The annual workshop was called to order by President Betty Hoffman on Thursday evening, November 13, 1969, at the Rosemead Women's Club in Rosemead, California. The hosting club was East San Gabriel Valley M.O.T.C.

Twenty-one clubs were present.

Slides from Colorado were shown to acquaint members who would be attending the National Convention in Denver.

The nominating chairman and committee were appointed. Members then broke into workshop discussion groups to talk about club-related issues and challenges.

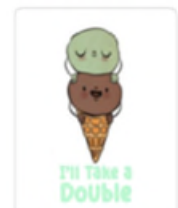

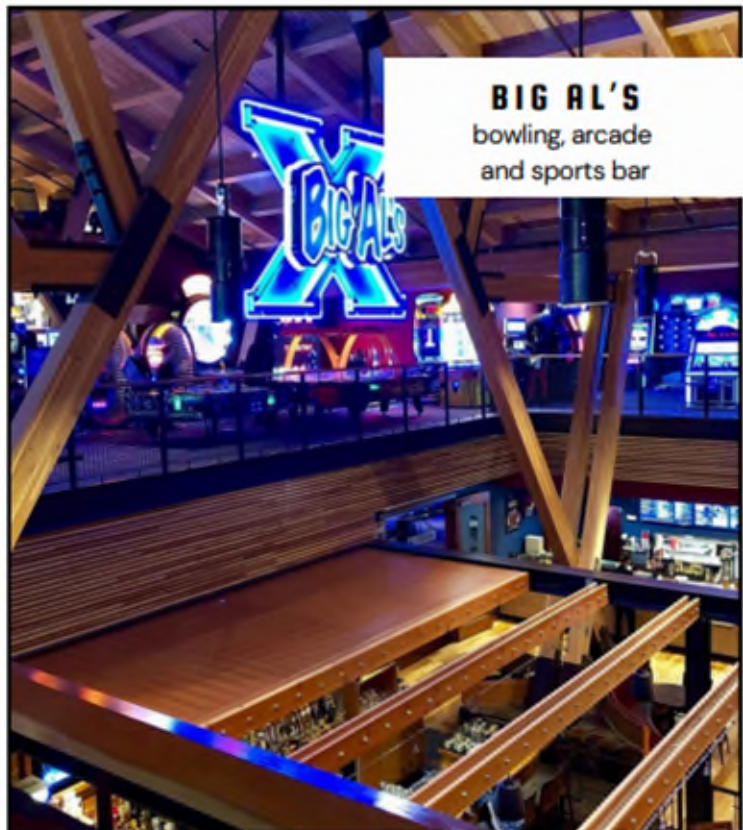
